The Aston-Mansfield Community Centre AMCC (formally the Froud Centre) is situated in bustling **Manor Park** and is an exciting hub of community activities and events.

AMCC offers a range of rooms for events, activities, training, sports classes, meetings and more. The centre is open 7 days a week. Rooms vary from capacity for 5 people to rooms for approximately 70 people, and our downstairs space has disabled access.

The Activity Space has dividing doors to split the space into two smaller rooms if needed as well as direct access to our courtyard space if you want to extend your activities outside or just get some cool airflow.






The Gandhi Room

Typically used for children/young people's activities, creative events or workshops and other community celebrations.







AMCC is on **Romford Road** and close to the **A406** making it easily accessible by car from Newham, London and beyond.

Unfortunately, AMCC can't offer any parking facilities. There is **street parking** available near-by, including **pay-by-phone** and **free parking after 5pm**. Please check signed restrictions before parking. Aston-Mansfield is not responsible for any parking fines incurred.



Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

Can I get a discount?

Aston-Mansfield is a charity, meaning we work and rent our spaces not-for-profit. We keep our rates as low as possible to make them as accessible to everyone in the community. We do offer a lower price (as indicated for each room) for charity or not-for-profit organisations and are happy to chat about finding a price which works for us and you.

Do you have a sound system in any of the rooms?

No – we currently don't have any sound systems set up in any of the rooms. However, you are more welcome to bring your own to use for your event.

Can we bring alcohol to our event?

Yes - we operate a 'sensible drinking' policy which we ask our hirers to acknowledge and sign prior to booking.

Is the site disability friendly?

Yes – we try to make our centres as accessible and disability friendly as possible. AMCC is an accessible building, including disabled toilets and a lift to the upper floors. Our the reception staff are trained on using an Evacuation Chairs.

Can we have tea and coffee?

Yes – booking a space gives you access to our tea and coffee point. To keep in line with our health and safety policy, this should only be accessed by the event/session organiser, who can take drinks to their space.

Can I have exclusive access to the courtyard?

Yes – both the Activity Space and Heronry Rooms are on the ground floor and have direct access to the courtyard. To have exclusive access of the courtyard, please mention your desire to use it when booking so we can make sure there are no clashes with other groups.
